

Camping Information Sheet

Your camping pass enables you to spend all of Saturday on the Farm and Sunday as well. We recommend that you arrive before midday on Saturday to take advantage of our shows starting at 1230. At 4pm you will be asked to drive your car up to reception from the car park where you will be escorted to the camping area. If you would rather not drive your car on the grass your equipment can be loaded into one of the farms vehicles. We will not be driving anywhere not accessible by a normal family sedan. After this we will set up camp and do a few after hours farming activities these will vary from night to night but may include a paddock walk, doing livestock checks, feeds and waters and learning about life on our farm. As you can imagine there is heaps of space for the kids to run and play. As the afternoon draws to a close we will start up the BBQ for dinner, your camp host is always looking for help so don't be afraid to pickup the tongs. After dinner there will be time to spot light for animals, roast marshmallows and tell a few tales around the campfire before heading to bed under the stars.

There is no more authentic farm experience than being woken by the rooster's crow in the morning! But your camp host will be already up and have the billy on for a cuppa before taking the kids up to the farm to collect some eggs for breakfast where bacon egg rolls are on the menu. After breakfast it will be time for the kids to help with animal feeds which will include picking vegetables straight from our garden.

Come mid morning we'll pack up camp and drive the vehicles back to the car park, when you're welcome to spend the day at the farm or head home.

What to bring.

Tent

Sleeping gear, Sleeping bag / Doona and something to sleep on i.e air mat

Camp chair.

Torches (you will not have power at your tent- you will also need a torch to go to the toilet approx 100m walk and for the nature walk)

Walking shoes (fully enclosed)

Beverages (esky)

Snacks / Special dietary requirements

Sun cream / insect repellent.

Warm jumper even during summer it can be cold at night.

Marshmallows for roasting over the fire
